This letter is regarding your building permit application received by our office on Feb. 15<sup>th</sup>, 2012 for an existing storage shed.

According to our records the shed does not meet the required 10' setback to the existing septic reserve area. A Revised Percolation Certification Plan must be submitted for approval to allow the shed in the current location. The requirements for the Percolation Certification Plan can be found at our website: [www.hchealth.org](http://www.hchealth.org) under Environmental Health – Well & Septic Program.

The plan submitted is also not to scale. A scaled drawing must be submitted depicting accurate dimensions of the shed and well and septic locations.

Enclosed is a copy of a plot plan showing the location of your septic reserve area. Your building permit will remain on hold until all requirements are met.
