The Health Department received your waiver request dated December 12, 2012 for the above referenced property. This agency will grant **approval** of the waiver to the required Percolation Certification Plan as required by the *Howard County Code, Subtitle 8, Section 3.805*. The waiver has been approved on the basis that the proposed addition does not increase the number of bedrooms in the home and there appears to be ample on-site sewage disposal system repair area.

Be advised that any future addition may require percolation testing and a Percolation Certification Plan will be required. Any deviations from the site plan submitted with the request will be subject to further review by this Department. A floor plan of the proposed addition must be submitted to the Health Department prior to approval of the building permit.
