This is to advise that the Howard County Health Department recommends issuance of the demolition permit for the above referenced property.

The current well (HO-15-0179) that was utilized for the above referenced property was properly will remain for use for the new house. The old pit well that once served this residence was properly located and sealed. This task was completed by J. Mayne (MSD 024) on 12/11/2015. The abandonment report was received by this office and confirmed by Carroll Water on 5/21/2018. Protective devices should be placed around the existing well and remain in place during demolition and construction.

The current septic system (tank and trench) will be utilized for the new house. Upon review of the new building permit, the Health Department will require the existing septic tank to be exposed to determine structural integrity as well as the size. Plans to rebuild on this parcel may require the generation of a percolation certification plan per Howard County Code.
